



# Crow's Feet

Those fine lines around the eyes are primarily caused by sun exposure and will increase with age. Smoking can also increase their intensity.

## Procedure | Injections

The injection will relax the muscles so they can't contract. It works by blocking the chemical signal that travels from your nerves to your muscles. Though Botox treatments are very safe they can still result in complications if the injection serum spreads beyond the treatment area, so you should only receive injections from a certified healthcare professional like our dentists at Paramount Dental Sydney.

There will be a few side effects including temporary bruising and headaches. While the bruising is rather common, the headaches are rare and should go away over the course of a couple of days. It is also important not to rub the treated area after an injection. Doing so may encourage the serum to seep into your eyelid muscles, causing them to droop.

Botox injections for the treatment of crow's feet take just a few minutes and can easily be done during your lunch hour. However, it takes several days for the effects to be seen and they last about 3 to 4 months.
