

Dental Bridges

Dental bridges look, feel and function like natural teeth; they don't require removal for cleaning; and they cost less than dental implants.

About

Dental bridges are used to replace missing teeth and fill a space where one or more teeth have been lost. They are created by connecting two or more dental crowns together. Unlike dentures, a bridge is bonded or cemented into place.

Caring For Your Dental Bridge

Make sure you brush twice a day with a softbristled toothbrush and don't forget to floss. Also avoid hard, sticky snacks.

Procedure

- 1. On your first visit, we prepare your teeth on either side of the gap as the bridge will be attached to these teeth.
- 2. We then take an impression of your teeth and while your bridge is being developed, a temporary bridge will be placed to protect your exposed teeth.
- 3. The bridge will be fitted on your second visit. Adjustments will be made before the bridge is bonded with a high-tech cement.
